Organising Pupils



It is also useful to consider how you use additional support to help with printing out of work and also displays. Printing frequently takes a long time and it is often not appropriate to use lesson time to do this. Discuss this with your ICT Coordinator, as this will be an issue for all the teaching staff.



Points to consider	Your response
Are pupils going to work alone on computers?	
Are you going to allocate each pupil a certain amount of time on a computer?	
Are you going to encourage those who have computers at home/easy access elsewhere to do the WWW research outside lesson time?	
If pupils are going to work in pairs, what kind of pairs? Friendship? Male/female?	
Where and how will pupils sit when you are setting up the task for them/closing the lesson etc., to maximize their concentration?	
What other activities can you have going on at the same time as the Internet research activity?	
What space have pupils got to work beside and/or away from the computers?	
Are you going to allow pupils to print directly from the Internet?	
Are you going to show pupils how to copy and paste information from the Internet?	
How are you going to 'close' the lesson?	
How should pupils leave the computers?
